### AN ACT REPEALING THE TAX ON LODGING HOUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of section one of chapter sixty-  
2 four G of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (c) of section 1 of said chapter 64G  
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 words "or lodging house" in the second line thereof.

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (d) of section 1 of chapter 64G of  
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 words "lodging house" in the first line thereof and by striking  
4 out the words "or lodging house" in the fourth and fifth lines  
5 thereof.

1 SECTION 4. Paragraph (e) of section 1 of chapter 64G of  
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 words "lodging house" in the second line thereof.

1 SECTION 5. Paragraph (f) of section 1 of chapter 64G of  
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 words "lodging house" in the second line thereof.

1 SECTION 6. Section 3 of chapter 64G of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the words "lodging house" in  
3 the second line thereof.

1 SECTION 7. Paragraph (a) of section 6 of chapter 64G of  
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 words "lodging house" in the first and fourth lines thereof.

1 SECTION 8. Paragraph (d) of section 6 of chapter 64G of  
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 words "lodging house" in the second and sixth lines  
4 thereof.
