AN ACT REQUIRING MOTOR VEHICLES HAULING CERTAIN TRAILERS TO HAVE ATTACHED TO BOTH SIDES MIRRORS OR REFLECTORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 7 of chapter 90 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-  
3 ing sentence: — Every motor vehicle to which is attached a  
4 utility or rental trailer or a trailer used for living purposes or  
5 tenting, the height of which trailer prevents the operator of  
6 the motor vehicle from having a constantly free and unobstruc-  
7 ted view of the highway immediately to the rear, shall have at-  
8 tached to the vehicle mirrors or reflectors on both sides so  
9 placed and adjusted as to afford the operator a clear, reflected  
10 view of the highway in the rear of the trailer.
