

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 3673

By Mr. Finnegan of Boston, petition of John J. Finnegan for prohibiting the granting of public assistance to persons who have not resided in the Commonwealth for at least one year. Public Welfare.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE GRANTING OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE TO PERSONS WHO HAVE NOT RESIDED IN THE COMMONWEALTH FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 116 of the General Laws is hereby amended by add-  
2 ing after section 7, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition  
3 the following section:—

4 *Section 8.* No person who has not established a domicile in  
5 the commonwealth and maintained the same for a period of  
6 one year or more next prior to his application for public as-  
7 sistance under the provisions of chapters one hundred seven-  
8 teen, one hundred eighteen, one hundred eighteen A or one  
9 hundred eighteen D of the General Laws shall be eligible to  
10 apply therefor or to receive the same.
