## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS THROUGH ITS DIVISION OF WATERWAYS TO CLEAR CERTAIN STREAMS IN THE TOWNS OF DRACUT AND TEWKSBURY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The department of public works, through its division of water-  
2 ways, is hereby authorized and directed to clear algae, weeds  
3 and other aquatic nuisances from Nuttings lake and Shawsheen  
4 river in the town of Billerica and Trull brook and Shawsheen  
5 river in the town of Tewksbury. For said purposes, said de-  
6 partment may expend such sums as may be appropriated there-  
7 for.

The Constitution of the State

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of twelve members, six of whom shall be chosen by the electors of the State, and six by the electors of the several counties.

Section 3. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen by the electors of the several counties, and the number of members shall not exceed thirty.

Section 4. The electors of the State shall meet on the first Monday after the first day of January, in the year 1847, and shall elect the first members of the Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 5. The electors of the several counties shall meet on the first Monday after the first day of January, in the year 1847, and shall elect the first members of the House of Representatives.
