

HOUSE No. 3751

By Mr. Gaudette of New Bedford, petition of Donald R. Gaudette for legislation to provide that no interest be charged to the owners of land assessed under the provisions of the New Bedford hurricane barrier project. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT NO INTEREST MAY BE CHARGED TO THE OWNER OF LAND ASSESSED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW BEDFORD HURRICANE BARRIER PROJECT IN THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 565 of the acts of 1962 is hereby amended
2 by striking out said section 5 and inserting in place thereof
3 the following section:—

4 *Section 5.* Up to fifty per cent of the amount each of the
5 above municipalities is obligated to pay to the commonwealth
6 under this act shall be assessed by said municipality on the
7 land benefited by said hurricane protection barrier, in accord-
8 ance with the provisions of chapter eighty of the General Laws;
9 provided, however, that the owner of such land shall not be re-
10 quired to pay any interest charge if payment is paid when due.
