## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NUMBER PLATES ISSUED BY THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR HOUSE TRAILERS AND CAMPING TRAILERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The seventh paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the fifth sen-  
3 tence thereof, as inserted by section 2 of chapter 819 of the  
4 acts of 1965, the following sentence:— The registrar may also  
5 furnish to the owners of house trailers or camping trailers  
6 plates to be limited in time as to their validity, but not for a  
7 period of less than six months, and the fee required under  
8 section thirty-three shall be reduced in proportion as to the  
9 time said plates are valid.
