AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A DECREE FOR ALIMONY ORDERING A CONVEYANCE OF REAL PROPERTY SHALL UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES CONSTITUTE A CONVEYANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 34A of chapter 208 of the General Laws, inserted by
2 chapter 415 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by striking
3 out, in lines 7 and 8, the words "at the time the decree of
4 divorce becomes absolute."
