AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF STATE AID TO CITIES AND TOWNS WHICH ARE MEMBERS OF CERTAIN REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 70 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 40 of chapter 14 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further
3 amended by adding the following sentence:— The school aid
4 to be paid, in any year, under this section to each city and town
5 comprising a regional school district, shall be increased by fif-
6 teen per cent wherein such regional school district includes a
7 kindergarten, grades one through twelve, inclusive, and grad-
8 uates not less than one hundred students.
