AN ACT PROHIBITING PROMOTIONAL VENTURES IN ESTABLISHMENTS  
ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF SELLING FOOD PRODUCTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the  
2 use of contests, games, trading stamps or other promotional  
3 ventures is hereby prohibited in all establishments engaged  
4 in or used for the selling of food products.
