## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH TO CONSTRUCT A MUNICIPAL SKATING RINK AND ARENA ON LAND KNOWN AS MORTON PARK IN SAID TOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Plymouth is hereby authorized to  
2 construct and operate a municipal skating rink and arena on  
3 land known as Morton park, which is located on the southeast  
4 side of Summer street in said town and is held as a park within  
5 the meaning of section seven of chapter forty-five of the General  
6 Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on its passage.

## The Constitution of the United States

As amended to January 19, 1919

The Constitution of the United States is the supreme law of the land. It is the foundation of the government and the rights of the people. It is the source of the power of the government and the source of the rights of the people.

The Constitution is divided into seven articles. The first three articles deal with the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of the government. The last four articles deal with the states, the federal government, and the rights of the people.

1. The executive branch is headed by the President of the United States.
2. The legislative branch is headed by the Congress of the United States.
3. The judicial branch is headed by the Supreme Court of the United States.
4. The states are guaranteed certain rights and powers.
5. The federal government is limited in its powers.
6. The rights of the people are protected by the Bill of Rights.
7. The Constitution is amended by a process known as ratification.

Article I. The legislative power shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
