AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL BOARD FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF CERTAIN PUPILS FROM ONE SCHOOL TO ANOTHER WITHIN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may establish a school trans-
2 portation board consisting of five persons to be appointed by
3 the mayor with the approval of the city council. Said board
4 shall promulgate rules and regulations relative to the transporta-
5 tion of pupils attending public schools in said city from one
6 school to another within said city and shall provide free trans-
7 portation of such pupils between such schools. The members of
8 said board shall serve without compensation, but may employ
9 an executive secretary and such other assistants as it may deem
10 necessary.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Boston.
