

HOUSE No. 4216

By Mr. Sacco of Medford, petition of George L. Sacco, Jr., that the salaries paid to members of the police department of the city of Medford shall not be less than the salaries paid to members of the Metropolitan District Commission police force. Local Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE SALARIES IN THE MEDFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN SALARIES IN THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION POLICE FORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of any
2 general or special law, the patrolmen and superior officers of
3 the Medford police department shall for the first two years of
4 service be paid a yearly salary which is not less than the yearly
5 salary being paid on the effective date of this act to patrolmen
6 and superior officers of corresponding rank and years of service
7 in such rank of the metropolitan district commission police
8 force for the first two years of service, and for the third year
9 and each year thereafter a salary equal to the maximum salary
10 paid to the metropolitan district commission police officer of
11 equal rank and years of service in such rank.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Medford.
