By Messrs. Burke of Worcester and Shea of Worcester, petition of Anthony J. Burke and C. Vincent Shea (with the approval of the city council) that the city of Worcester be authorized to pay a certain sum of money to the Vernon Hill Post, American Legion, for the rental of quarters. Local Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR PAYMENT OF AND TO PAY A CERTAIN MORAL OBLIGATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to
2 the contrary, the city of Worcester is hereby authorized to
3 appropriate money for the payment of, and after such
4 appropriation the treasurer of said city is hereby authorized
5 to pay a moral obligation to the Vernon Hill Post, A.L. No.
6 435, Inc., duly incorporated in the commonwealth of Massa-
7 chusetts for the rental of quarters for the year nineteen hun-
8 dred and sixty in the amount of five hundred and fifty-two
9 dollars which bill is legally unenforceable against said city by
10 reason of it being incurred in a different fiscal year from the
11 current year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 during the current year by the city of Worcester.
