*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:*

It has been brought to my attention by the Commissioner of Education, Owen B. Kiernan, that the building and property at 200 Newbury Street, Boston, which has been used as the Administrative Office for the Department of Education, is now surplus to the needs of the Department and he recommends that this property be disposed of.

The State Board of Education at a meeting held November 7, 1966 unanimously voted to dispose of this same property. In accordance with this request, pursuant to General Laws Chapter 7, Section 4, I transmit for your consideration the attached proposed legislation.

Upon enactment of this proposed legislation, it is the intent of this office to obtain at least one professional appraisal prior to the disposition of this property.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DISPOSE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF BOSTON UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The board of education is hereby authorized to dispose of, by  
2 sale, upon recommendation of the commissioner of administra-  
3 tion and with the approval of the governor, the building and  
4 property under its jurisdiction at 200 Newbury street in the  
5 city of Boston which was used as the administrative offices for  
6 said department and certified by the board of education that  
7 such property is no longer necessary in the operation of the  
8 department of education.
