RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE IMMEDIATE REMOVAL OF A DEAD BODY FROM CERTAIN ESTABLISHMENTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study of
3 the subject matter of current house document numbered 3056,
4 requiring the immediate removal of a dead body from certain
5 establishments. Said department shall report to the general
6 court the results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
7 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation neces-
8 sary to carry such recommendations into effect by filing the
9 same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or be-
10 fore May first, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
