1 *Ordered*, That a special committee, to consist of five
2 members of the house of representatives to be designated by
3 the speaker thereof, be authorized to make an investigation
4 of the accident at City Square, Charlestown on Tuesday,
5 March seventh, involving two trains of the Massachusetts
6 Bay Transportation Authority. Said committee shall be
7 provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere,
8 may hold hearings, and may expend for clerical and other
9 assistance and expenses such sums as may be appropriated
10 therefor. Said committee shall report to the house of repre-
11 sentatives the results of its investigation, and its recommenda-
12 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to
13 carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same
14 with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before
15 June first, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
