AN ACT PROVIDING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR A CITY OR TOWN CLERK WHO IS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRARS OF VOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 19F the following section:—
- 3 *Section 19G.* A clerk of a city or town who also serves as a
- 4 member of its board of registrars of voters shall, in addition
- 5 to any compensation to which he may be entitled as clerk,
- 6 receive the sum of fifty dollars for each one thousand
- 7 registered voters or major fraction thereof, provided, how-
- 8 ever, that the total payment for such service as a member
- 9 said board shall not exceed fifteen hundred dollars in any
- 10 year.
