AN ACT RELATIVE TO GARAGE FACILITIES TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 689 of the Acts of 1966 is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 1 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following section:—

4 *Section 1.* Notwithstanding the provision of any special or
5 general law to the contrary, the state treasurer is hereby
6 authorized and directed to transfer a sum of money not to
7 exceed one hundred and fifty thousand dollars to the Spring-
8 field street railway system for the purpose of constructing
9 garage facilities in the city of Springfield, said monies to be
10 transferred from that portion of the proceeds of the excise on
11 cigarettes as authorized by paragraph (b) of section twenty-
12 eight of chapter sixty-four C of the General Laws.
