AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 12 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 15, as amended by section 1 of chapter
3 743 of the acts of 1963, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section:—

5 *Section 15.* District attorneys shall receive from the com-
6 monwealth salaries as follows:—

7 For the Suffolk district, twenty thousand dollars.

8 For the northern district, eighteen thousand five hundred
9 dollars.

10 For the eastern district, seventeen thousand dollars.

11 For the middle district, fifteen thousand dollars.

12 For the Norfolk district, seventeen thousand dollars.

13 For the Plymouth district, fifteen thousand dollars.

14 For the southern district, fifteen thousand dollars.

15 For the western district, fourteen thousand dollars.

16 For the northeastern district, nine thousand four hundred
