In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE STATE TAX COMMISSION RELATIVE TO METHODS OF COLLECTING DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS OWED THE COMMONWEALTH AND CITIES AND TOWNS.

1     *Resolved*, That the state tax commission is hereby author-  
2 ized and directed to make an investigation and study of the  
3 subject matter of the investigation and study proposed by  
4 current house document numbered 2949, relative to methods  
5 of collecting delinquent accounts owed the commonwealth  
6 and cities and towns. Said commission shall report to the  
7 general court the results of its investigation and study, and  
8 its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-  
9 tion necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by  
10 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives  
11 on or before the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hun-  
12 dred and sixty-eight.
