RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO CERTAIN CIVIL SERVICE AND PUBLIC PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATION MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission, established by
2 chapter eighty of the resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-
3 five and most recently revived and continued by chapter one
4 hundred and twelve of the resolves of nineteen hundred and
5 sixty-six, shall, in the course of its investigation and study,
6 consider the subject matter of current house documents
7 numbered 1338, regulating the hiring of certain emergency
8 laborers in the department of public works; 2149, regulating
9 temporary summer employment and emergency appoint-
10 ments of agencies of the commonwealth; and 3384, regulat-
11 ing the hiring of emergency laborers in any department or
12 agency of the commonwealth.
