1 *Ordered*, That the committee on insurance be authorized
2 to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of
3 making an investigation and study of the subject matter of cur-
4 rent house document numbered 2595, relative to certain motor
5 vehicle policies issued by insurance companies for property dam-
6 age or guest coverage so-called.

7 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
8 house or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within
9 the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other ser-
10 vices and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
11 Said committee shall report to the general court the results of
12 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
13 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such rec-
14 ommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
15 the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of
16 January, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
