1 *Ordered*, That the committee on highways and motor
2 vehicles be authorized to sit during the recess of the general
3 court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of
4 the subject matter of the investigation and study proposed by
5 current house document 2869, relative to the effect of lighting
6 of signs and commercial and other establishments along
7 travelled ways.

8 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
9 house or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel
10 within the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and
11 other services and expenses such sums as may be appro-
12 priated therefor. Said committee shall report to the general
13 court the results of its investigation and study, and its
14 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
15 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing
16 the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
17 before the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and
18 sixty-eight.
