AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DISCHARGE OF CERTAIN LIENS PLACED UPON THE PROPERTY OF A DEPENDENT MOTHER OR FATHER OF A PERSON WHO WAS KILLED IN ACTION OR WHO DIED FROM SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITIES INCURRED IN WARTIME SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The veterans' agent of each city and town shall discharge any
2 lien placed under chapter one hundred and fifteen of the General
3 Laws prior to September tenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-
4 two, upon the property of a dependent mother or father of a
5 veteran, who, while in the armed forces of the United States
6 during wartime, was killed in action or died from a service-
7 connected disability incurred in wartime service.
