### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICER IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE DORCHESTER DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 62, as most recently amended by chapter  
3 802 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following section:—

5 *Section 62.* In the municipal court of the city of Boston the  
6 court officers appointed shall not exceed ten for criminal  
7 business, one of whom shall be designated by the chief justice  
8 as chief court officer of said court for criminal business and  
9 one as an assistant chief court officer, nor five for civil  
10 business, one of whom shall be designated by said chief  
11 justice as chief court officer of said court for civil business; in  
12 the municipal court of the Dorchester district and the Rox-  
13 bury district six court officers may be appointed; in the third  
14 district court of eastern Middlesex, the central district court  
15 of Worcester five court officers may be appointed; in the mu-  
16 nicipal court of the West Roxbury district, in the district  
17 court of Somerville and in the fourth district court of eastern  
18 Middlesex three court officers may be appointed; in the

19 municipal court of the South Boston district, of the Charles-  
 20 town district, the East Boston district court, the district court  
 21 of Chelsea, the first district court of eastern Middlesex, the  
 22 second district court of eastern Middlesex, the district court  
 23 of Springfield, the district court of East Norfolk, the district  
 24 court of Newton and the district court of northern Norfolk  
 25 two court officers for each court may be appointed; and in  
 26 each of the other district courts in the commonwealth one  
 27 court officer may be appointed.
