AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 12 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 15, as amended by section 1 of chapter 743 of
3 the acts of 1963, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 15.* District attorneys shall receive from the com-
6 monwealth salaries as follows:—

7 For the Suffolk district, twenty-six thousand dollars.

8 For the northern district, eighteen thousand five hundred
9 dollars.

10 For the eastern district, sixteen thousand dollars.

11 For the middle district, sixteen thousand dollars.

12 For the Norfolk district, fifteen thousand dollars.

13 For the Plymouth district, fourteen thousand dollars.

14 For the southern district, fifteen thousand dollars.

15 For the western district, fifteen thousand dollars.

16 For the northwestern district, ten thousand dollars.
