RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

1    *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three mem-  
2 bers of the senate, five members of the house of representatives,  
3 and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
4 established for the purpose of making an investigation and  
5 study relative to the finances and operation of the Massachu-  
6 setts Bay Transportation Authority, including but not limited  
7 to the salaries of officers, consultants' fees, and the methods of  
8 assessment of deficits, with a view toward revision of the laws  
9 pertaining thereto, together with such other matters related  
10 thereto as it may deem advisable. Said commission shall in-  
11 clude in its investigation and study the subject-matter of cur-  
12 rent house document numbered 5024, authorizing the com-  
13 mittee on Transportation to sit during the recess of the General  
14 Court to study the subject-matter of various current Senate  
15 and House documents.
