## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT CONTINUING AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON DISADVANTAGED CHILDREN AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PRESCRIBE SPECIAL PROGRAMS FOR SAID CHILDREN IN ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS AND TO ASSIST CITIES, TOWNS AND REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN ESTABLISHING SAID PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 8 of chapter 650 of the acts of 1964 is hereby amended
- 2 by striking out, in line 2, the word "sixty-seven" an inserting
- 3 in place thereof the word: — seventy.
