## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FOURTH ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE WEST ROXBURY DISTRICT, A THIRD ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE CENTRAL DISTRICT COURT OF NORTHERN ESSEX AND A SECOND ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF BARNSTABLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the paragraph inserted by  
3 chapter 533 of the acts of 1966 and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following paragraph: —

5 Fourth assistant clerks with salaries payable by the county  
6 may be appointed in the municipal court of the Dorchester  
7 district and in the municipal court of the West Roxbury district.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said section 10, as  
2 most recently amended by chapter 474 of the acts of 1964 is  
3 hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the words:  
4 — and the central district court of northern Essex.

1 SECTION 3. The third sentence of the first paragraph of said  
2 section 10, as most recently amended by chapter 710 of the acts  
3 of 1966 is hereby further amended by inserting at the end  
4 thereof the words: — and the first district court of Barnstable.
