RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE FOR ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A BRANCH OF THE STATE HOUSE FACILITIES ON BELMONT STREET IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

1 *Resolved*, That the executive office for administration and
2 finance is hereby authorized and directed to make an investiga-
3 tion and study of the subject matter of current house document
4 numbered 5124, providing for an investigation and study by a
5 special commission relative to the feasibility of establishing a
6 branch of the state house facilities on Belmont street in the city
7 of Worcester. Said executive office for administration and
8 finance shall report to the general court the results of its investi-
9 gation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
10 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations
11 into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the house of repre-
12 sentatives on or before the last Wednesday of December in the
13 current year.
