The Senate committee on Ways and Means, to whom was referred the Order relative to the appointment of a joint special committee to study the subject matter of current Senate document numbered 210, relative to premium finance agencies as regulated by the Commissioner of Banks (Senate, No. 1162), report that the same ought to be adopted in the form of a new draft herewith submitted (House, No. 5237).

1 *Ordered*, That a joint special committee to consist of two
2 members of the Senate and five members of the House of
3 Representatives be appointed to make an investigation and
4 study of the subject-matter of current Senate document
5 numbered 210, relative to premium finance agencies as regu-
6 lated by the Commissioner of Banks. Said committee shall be
7 provided with quarters in the State House; may hire clerical
8 and other assistance; may hold hearings and may travel
9 within the Commonwealth.

10 Said committee may expend for said purposes, such sums
11 as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report
12 to the General Court by filing its recommendations, together
13 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommenda-
14 tions into effect, by filing its report with the Clerk of the
15 Senate on or before the fourth Wednesday of January,
16 nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
