AN ACT REVIVING THE GREAT FOUR, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven of chapter
2 one hundred and fifty-six of the General Laws. The Great
3 Four, Inc., a corporation established under the laws of the
4 commonwealth, whose charter expired on December twenty-
5 third, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, is hereby revived and
6 shall be and remain a body corporate for an indefinite term
7 of years after said expiration date, with the same powers,
8 duties and obligations as if said charter had not so expired;
9 subject, however, to the provisions of chapter one hundred
10 and fifty-six B of the General Laws, and all acts and pro-
11 ceedings of the stockholders, directors and officers acting as
12 such which would have been legal and valid but for the
13 expiration of said charter are hereby ratified and confirmed.
