AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LAWRENCE TO BORROW MONEY INSIDE ITS DEBT LIMIT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REHABILITATING, RECONSTRUCTING AND MAKING EXTRAORDINARY REPAIRS TO ITS MUNICIPAL INCINERATOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lawrence may, from time to time,
2 borrow such sums as may be necessary, not to exceed in the
3 aggregate one hundred and fifty thousand dollars for the
4 purpose of paying necessary expenses and liabilities in con-
5 nection with rehabilitating, reconstructing and making extra-
6 ordinary repairs to its municipal incinerator, and may issue
7 bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the
8 words "Lawrence Incinerator Repairs Loan, Act of 1967."
9 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and
10 each such loan shall be payable in not more than ten years
11 from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall
12 be inside the limit of indebtedness as prescribed by section
13 ten of chapter forty-four of the General Laws and shall,
14 except as provided herein, be subject to the provisions of said
15 chapter forty-four, including the payment of a sum equal to
16 ten per cent of the amount authorized to be borrowed pur-
17 suant to the limitation contained in the first paragraph of
18 section seven thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
