AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO PAY THE WIDOW OF JOHN F. KANE AN ANNUITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
2 and for the purpose of promoting the public good, the city
3 of Springfield may pay the widow of former firefighter John
4 F. Kane an annuity in the amount which she would receive
5 if the said John F. Kane had elected to retire under the pro-
6 visions of option (d) of subdivision (2) of section twelve of
7 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.
