## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT REVISING STATUTORY SALARIES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to provide without delay addi-  
3 tional compensation for certain employees of the common-  
4 wealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency  
5 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
6 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Paragraph (f) of section 43 of chapter 31 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in section 72 of chapter 801 of the acts of  
3 1963, is hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—  
5 Whenever any hearing is held by a member of the commis-  
6 sion or some disinterested person designated by the chairman  
7 of the commission, as authorized by paragraph (b) of this  
8 section, such person shall be paid a sum not to exceed thirty-  
9 five dollars per day; and such compensation shall be in  
10 addition to any compensation provided for in section two A  
11 of chapter thirteen.
