### AN ACT EXEMPTING GRAVESTONES FROM THE LAW IMPOSING A TEMPORARY TAX ON RETAIL SALES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Subsection 6 of section 1 of chapter 14 of the acts of 1966 is

- 4 (n) Sales of gravestones or coffins, caskets, burial garments
- 5 or other materials which are ordinarily sold by a funeral
- 6 director as part of the business of funeral directing.
