

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 354

By Mr. Turner of Lee, petition of Warren A. Turner for regulating the placing of certain traffic signs on state highways having four or more lanes. Transportation.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT REGULATING THE PLACING OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC SIGNS ERECTED ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 27 of chapter 85 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 646 of the acts of 1951, is  
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence,  
4 the following sentence:—

5 All direction signs erected on state highways having four or  
6 more lanes, shall be installed at a height of not less than fifteen  
7 feet measured perpendicularly from the centerpoint of the bot-  
8 tom of the sign to the surface of the road, and shall be within  
9 the confines of those lanes being traveled by the traffic intended  
10 to be directed by said signs.
