RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PRESENT FORMULA FOR ASSESSING COSTS OF THE MAINTENANCE OF RESERVATIONS AND BOULEVARDS IN THE METROPOLITAN PARKS DISTRICT ON THE VARIOUS CITIES AND TOWNS IN SAID DISTRICT.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investiga-
5 tion and study of the present formula for assessing costs of
6 the maintenance of reservations and boulevards in the met-
7 ropolitan parks district on the various cities and towns in said
