

HOUSE No. 435

By Mr. Kerr of Agawam, petition of Walter T. Kerr and another that persons engaged in selling, repairing or exchanging weighing and measuring devices be required to give certain information to local departments of weights and measures. Commerce and Labor.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT A PERSON ENGAGED IN SELLING, REPAIRING, REBUILDING OR EXCHANGING NEW OR USED WEIGHING AND MEASURING DEVICES GIVE CERTAIN NOTIFICATION TO WEIGHTS AND MEASURES OFFICIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Every person engaged in selling, repairing, rebuilding or
2 exchanging new or used weighing and measuring devices shall
3 notify, in writing, within 10 days, the department of weights
4 and measures in whose jurisdiction the said device is located
5 giving name and address of the person for whom such repair
6 has been made or to whom a repaired, rebuilt, exchanged,
7 new or used weighing or measuring device has been sold or
8 delivered. Whoever violates any provision of this section
9 shall be punished for the first offense by a fine of not less than
10 fifty dollars, for the second offense by a fine of not less than
11 one hundred dollars and for a subsequent offense by a fine of
12 not less than five hundred dollars.
