AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW PROHIBITING THE PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION TO SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 52 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as amended
2 by chapter 90 of the acts of 1932, is hereby further amended
3 by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence:—Each member of a school
5 committee shall be compensated for his services at such rate
6 as may be established by vote of the city council in a city or
7 by vote of a town meeting in a town.
