**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LAW SCHOOL AT  
THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 23, under the caption University of  
3 Massachusetts Law School, the following section:—

4 *Section 23A.* The trustees shall establish and maintain at  
5 Amherst a graduate school for instruction in basic legal sub-  
6 jects, to be known as the University of Massachusetts Law  
7 School. There shall be a three-year course of instruction in  
8 law and those subjects shall be taught which are ordinarily  
9 required for a legal education.

10 The law school shall achieve and maintain the standards of  
11 legal education prescribed by the American Bar Association  
12 and other recognized legal societies for grade A law schools.

13 Of the students admitted to the law school, not less than  
14 ninety per cent shall be legal residents of the commonwealth,  
15 and they shall be selected solely on the basis of academic  
16 promise.
