AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 8, paragraph (a) and inserting in place
3 thereof the following new section 8, paragraph (a) as follows:—
4 *Section 8. (a)* With respect to any period of insurance which
5 is in effect for an employee, there shall be withheld from each
6 payment of salary or wages of such employee an amount equal
7 to one hundred per cent of the premium of any additional op-
8 tional insurance and the commonwealth shall contribute the
9 entire premium of the basic life and hospital, surgical, medical
10 insurance.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 1, Clause 1: All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
