AN ACT ALLOWING PART TIME EMPLOYMENT BY RETIRED EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding after the last sentence the following:—
3 Notwithstanding any provisions of this act a person who has
4 reached mandatory retirement age may accept part time em-
5 ployment from the commonwealth or one of its subdivisions
6 provided that the remuneration from such position plus his
7 pension does not exceed the current salary of the position he
8 held at the time of his mandatory retirement. Such part time
9 employment shall not in any way affect the pension or retire-
10 ment allowance payable to such employee.
