AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CITIES AND TOWNS FOR LOSS OF TAXES THROUGH ABATEMENTS GRANTED TO VETERANS BLINDED AS A RESULT OF A SERVICE CONNECTED DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8A of chapter 58 of the General Laws, as amended
2 by chapter 687 of the acts of 1957, is hereby further amended
3 by inserting after the word "veteran", in line 4, the words:—,
4 or to a veteran blinded as a result of a service connected
5 disability, or to the widow of such blinded veteran.
