By Messrs. Dukakis of Brookline, Backman of Brookline and Linsky of Brookline, petition of George V. Brown, Jr., and others (by vote of the town) that the town of Brookline be authorized to pay a certain sum of money to Northeast Sales and Service, Inc. Local Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO NORTHEAST SALES & SERVICE, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
2 tion, the town of Brookline is hereby authorized to appro-
3 priate money for the payment of, and after such appropria-
4 tion the treasurer of said town is hereby authorized to pay, an
5 unpaid bill in the amount of three thousand nine hundred
6 and ninety-five dollars to Northeast Sales & Service, Inc., a
7 corporation organized under the laws of Massachusetts, for
8 the installation of a new engine in a Walter Snow Fighter
9 owned by the town, said bill being legally unenforceable by
10 reason of its not having been incurred pursuant to the
11 provisions of the General Laws and town by-laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

That the House of Representatives of the United States of America do hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the original as the same appears in the records of the House of Representatives.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the following be and they are hereby enacted into law.

- 1. Section 1. For the purpose of determining the order of precedence in the House of Representatives in the event of a tie, the following shall apply: (a) The order of precedence shall be determined by the seniority of the members of the House of Representatives in the House of Representatives.
- 2. Section 2. The House of Representatives shall have the right to determine the order of precedence in the House of Representatives in the event of a tie.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect on the passage.
