AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT OF
CERTAIN MINORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 66 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 95 of the acts of 1967, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the period at the end thereto
4 and adding the following:—nor prohibit the employment of
5 any female of eighteen years of age or over in a restaurant
6 or other public eating facilities until, but not after, twelve
7 midnight.
