AN ACT RESTRICTING THE AVOIDANCE OF COVERAGE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY POLICY BY THE INSURER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby further
2 amended by inserting after section 112 the following sec-
3 tion:—

4 *Section 112A.* No statement made by the insured or on his
5 behalf in securing a motor liability policy insuring against
6 liability for loss or damage on account of bodily injury or
7 death, or for loss or damage resulting therefrom, or on
8 account of damage to property, nor any violation of the
9 terms of such policy either prior or subsequent to issue
10 thereof, nor any on default of the insured shall operate to
11 defeat or avoid the policy so as to bar recovery within the
12 limits of such policy by a judgment creditor of the insured,
13 unless the insurer shall prove material prejudice by acts or
14 omissions of the insured. Both parties shall have a right to a
15 trial by jury on the issue of material prejudice.
