## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR UNUSED SICK LEAVE CREDITS TO BE CREDITED FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 to section 4 the following subdivision (5) to read as follows:—
- 3 (5) Any member shall on his retirement be credited with service
- 4 toward retirement in the amount of the unused number of sick
- 5 leave days to his credit.
