AN ACT CLARIFYING PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATIVE TO PROVIDING
FOR THE ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVE BARGAINING AGENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 178K of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as inserted
2 by section 2 of chapter 763 of the acts of 1965, is hereby amended
3 by inserting, in line 9 after the word "organizations" and before
4 the period, the following clause: — , and the cost of any use of
5 such other arbitration tribunals shall be divided equally between
6 the municipal employer and the employee organization.
