AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT WELFARE AID BE CONTINUED FOR ANY RECIPIENT PENDING RESULT OF AN APPEAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OR THE COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of chapter 118 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 chapter 248 of the acts of 1939, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the word "board" in line 14, and replacing therewith the
4 following: — board, and aid payments shall not be discontinued
5 by any board until a decision by the department on such appeal
6 has been made known to the appellant or until a decision on an
7 appeal taken in the courts.
